Qualifications

APPLICANTS ARE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE ONLY ONE SCHOLARSHIP IN A LIFETIME FROM BBIA AND MUST:

- Be an entering or returning student to an accredited college or Tom P. Haney Technical College
- Be accepted for enrollment to an accredited college or Tom P. Haney Technical College
- Be enrolled at least half-time
- Meet all program and school requirements
- Before scholarship funds are released to recipient and accredited college, completed college acceptance documentation (student ID #, name and address of college attending) must be received by the BBIA Scholarship Committee

Preference given to the following programs at Haney Technical College: Welding, Electrician, Computer Systems and Information Technology, A/C Refrigeration and Heating and

- Complete the BBIA Scholarship Application and submit to BBIA Office by appropriate deadlines
- Not be in default on any federal or state loans

Selection

- Scholarships are based on funds availability.
- Applicants associated with BBIA and its members will be given priority.
